How to contact your MS nurse



The MS nurse specialist is an experienced nurse who is able to provide support, advice and information to anyone with Multiple Sclerosis (MS), their families and friends in the West Berkshire area.

We can also be useful contacts for other professionals who may need specialist advice or help in MS related issues.

We see people in the clinics, which are held at:

- Royal Berkshire Hospital, Reading
- West Berkshire Community Hospital, Thatcham
- Wokingham Community Hospital
- Bracknell Healthspace Clinic
- MS Therapy Centre in Reading.

If you are not able to come to the hospital, then we will make arrangements to see you at home, although this is a limited service.

Once the neurologist has diagnosed MS, we work together with you and the neurology team to devise the best possible way of meeting your particular needs, especially in terms of symptom management.

With the broad practical experience that the nurses have, they are a useful contact in helping people to adjust to changes and any difficulties that may arise from time to time.

There is an answer phone as well as an email facility. Messages are picked up Monday to Friday between 9am and 12 noon.
