What are they all for?

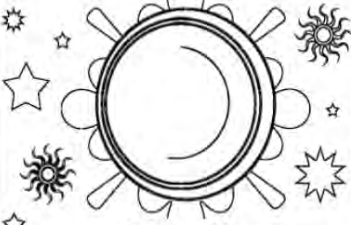
First there is the **SUIT LAMP**

Just like looking through a **MAGIC WINDOW**

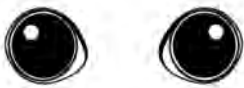
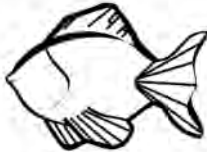
