

Advice for relatives, care partners, carers and friends



- Visiting between 2pm and 8pm daily.
- Only **TWO VISITORS** per patient at a time please.
- **OPEN VISITING** for carers, care partners and relatives of patients with dementia, learning disabilities, and those at the end of their life.
- Friends and relatives can also stay in touch with patients by smart device / mobile. There are iPads on the wards so you can safely communicate via video / social media.
- Please wear a face mask on wards or whilst in clinical areas.
- **DO NOT VISIT** if you are feeling unwell or have any symptoms of COVID, colds, FLU and other respiratory infections or vomiting and diarrhoea.
- Please maintain good hand hygiene before and after visiting.
