Our website uses a tool called **ReachDeck** (to read aloud and translate text).

It can translate the information on the website into many languages. It can also speak the translated text in some languages.

The ReachDeck toolbar looks like this and is found on the home page (may look different if viewed on a mobile phone).

To translate our web pages:

1. Click on the ReachDeck icon (usually top right of screen).		(
