The Rosemary Centre

The Chemotherapy service at the Rosemary Centre is a nurse-led unit offering a range of chemotherapy and anti-cancer treatments. It is staffed and managed by the team at our main chemotherapy base, King Edward Ward, at the Royal Berkshire Hospital.

Referrals to the unit

Referrals to the unit will be made by your oncology consultant, clinical nurse specialist or chemotherapy team. Treating people at The Rosemary Centre will be a clinical decision based on the type of treatment you are having and capacity within the unit.

Important note

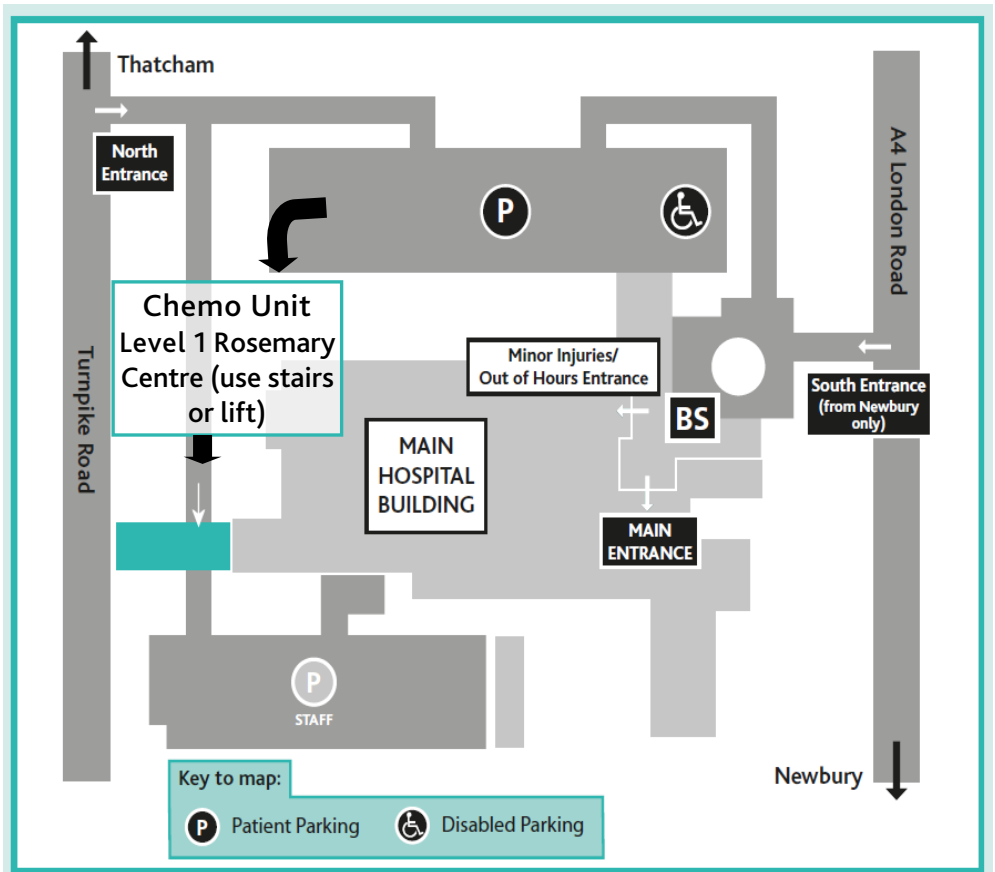
As a satellite unit, we do not have access to pharmacy services or medical cover (doctors). It is important to let us know the day before treatment if you need additional take home medication, if you are unwell or if you have any questions about your treatment.
