

All mobility aids including:

- Frames
- Crutches
- Walking sticks

locations: South Block entrance, outside the Orthopaedic Clinic in South Block or near Main Reception

Cannot be returned to RBH

- Toileting equipment (e.g., toilet frames, commodes, raised toilet seats)
