Introduction to the Breast Multi- Disciplinary Team (MDT)

This leaflet provides you and your family or friends with information about the multi-disciplinary team (MDT) involved in your care at the Royal Berkshire Hospital. There are also some useful telephone numbers and website addresses which you may find helpful.

The Multi-Disciplinary Team

It is the policy of the MDT that all patients with a new diagnosis of breast cancer (irrespective of age and stage of the disease) will be discussed at a multi-disciplinary team meeting (MDTM) at the earliest opportunity. At this meeting the team will discuss individual treatment plans and follow-up arrangements to ensure that every patient with cancer receives the best possible care. These meetings will also be an opportunity to discuss difficult cases at any stage during treatment if necessary. The meetings take place weekly.

Who are the breast cancer MDT?

- **Designated lead clinician (chair)** with overall responsibility for the service
- **Designated breast cancer surgeon(s)**
- **Oncologist** with expertise in radiotherapy and chemotherapy
- **Radiologist** expert in looking at tumour sites on an x-ray or scan
- **Histopathologist** with expertise in looking at the cells of tumour sites from biopsies
- **Clinical Nurse Specialist (Key Worker)** who will provide information and support for patients
- **MDT Co-ordinator**
- **Nurse Practitioners**
- **Research Nurse** provides information to the team on any new trials
- **Screening Nurse**
- **Surgical and oncology registrars and junior doctors**
