

The scan of your baby is an important clinical examination

At 12 and 20 weeks, we offer an ultrasound scan to check your baby for major structural abnormalities. The scan looks in detail at baby's size, bones, heart, brain, spinal cord, face, kidneys and abdomen. It allows the sonographer to look specifically for 11 conditions, some of which are very rare and difficult to see. The scan cannot always identify every problem.



To enable the sonographer to undertake this examination it is important that the area is quiet and distractions kept to a minimum.

Sonographers will explain their findings to you at the end of examination but may be quiet for periods of time while they concentrate on examining your baby.

- All phones, tablets and electronic devices to be turned off.
